

## Water Treatment Operator - Nathrop, CO

We are a homeowners association (HOA) community with 306 privately owned lots in Nathrop, CO. Our water treatment facility is a groundwater system. As the sole water treatment operator for our community, you would be responsible for all aspects of the system's operation and maintenance. Salary level will be commensurate with experience. The position generally involves 8–10 hours of work per week related to the water system, though additional time may be necessary during emergencies

### Job Requirements:

- High School diploma or general education degree (GED)
- Possess a valid Colorado driver's license
- Minimum of one year of industry experience (preferred)
- Must possess a minimum of a Colorado Water Treatment Operator (D) and Water Distribution System Operator (1)

### Job Responsibilities:

- Engages in the daily operation and maintenance of the water system including but not limited to production, treatment and storage facilities, and delivery of water in the community.
- Participates in the repair and maintenance of water facilities, including grounds, plants, wells, pump stations, storage tanks, valves, hydrants, pressure regulating stations, and related equipment.
- Interprets and implements laboratory, mechanical, and operational data.
- Collects and analyzes water samples taken throughout the distribution system by performing standard chemical and physical examinations.
- Conducts installation inspections, locates lines, leak identification and emergency response to a water main break.
- Oversees and manages the handling, storage, and dosing of water treatment chemicals, ensuring compliance with safety guidelines.
- Maintains detailed records of equipment maintenance, water quality testing, and compliance documentation.
- Participates in emergency response procedures, troubleshooting issues, and making critical decisions to maintain water supply. This position requires being on call for water-related emergencies.

Successful candidates will complete pre-employment screening, which includes, but is not limited to a criminal background check, drug screen, and physical.
