- Water Projects Completed and Pending:
 - Vacuum Breaker process
 - Water and Sewer Asset Inventory
 - Hydrant status (24 broken, 2 fixed, 22 more)
 - Winter Water Installations so far (214 currently installed)
 - Replacement parts, values, estimated lifespan of equipment
 - CRWA (Colorado Rural Water Association)
 - Winter Water Installation application and requirements online
 - Vacuum Breakers status and future plan

Grant Possibilities & Options

- CDPHE (Colorado Dept. Public Health)
- Colorado Water Conservation Board
 - Raw Water Grants (if the South well does not produce after shock treatment(25% \$ match required)
 - Water Plan Funding Categories (upgrades to our system)
- USDA
 - We can ask for a forgiveness of our current sewer loan
 - We can apply for a 80%grant/20%loan program for our water system once the engineering is done

Water Decree





- 2nd RVs must check in 3 days prior. Forms are online. You must have a permit in your window before arrival.


